We started out in two rooms leased from a church, and moved into a home of our own in 2007. A renovation of an existing building was blessed by an on-time, under-budget completion for up to 176 students. As we continue to grow substantially—our enrollment is at its highest— we find an immediate need for additional space.

Sophia Academy educates and remediates students in shorter stays, and is available with full on-grade curriculum for kindergarten through eighth grade. As our students come to us behind in some area, we feel that providing superior opportunities can make the “specialized school” environment into a “regular school” environment.

A multi-purpose building including a gym, auditorium and cafeteria will not only add to the full experience of our students, but also become a community resource to bring awareness to our school.

Standards of the Georgia High School Association will be met, allowing us to host indoor sports to any schools, and add a revenue source to our budget. A commercial kitchen will both allow more nutritional food options and provide hospitality space for our events and leased events. Auditorium space will increase options for our theater program. All of our students participate in our drama program, as this

language-rich medium benefits learning and highlights student strengths.

Space will allow us to build out for high school classrooms when we add a high school. Research has shown us how important sports and other extracurriculars are to older students—to participate and to spectate.
